

Citation Rules of Thumb

These are the rules of thumb for identifying and entering citations and citation references.

Identifying Citations

1. Do not map introductory material.

Entering Citations

- 1. Copy the Citation guidance directly from the Authority Document.
- 2. Do not copy notes or explanatory text.
- 3. Do not copy whole parenthetical sentences or paragraphs.
- 4. Remove bullets from bulleted text and replace them with simple dashes.
- 5. Enter bulleted text with preceding lines or paragraphs.
- 6. Separate unnumbered paragraphs.

Citation References

- 1. Use the document suggested reference format when it exists.
- 2. Include text with numbers when the Authority document is a law or regulation.
- 3. Include section or paragraph marks when the document uses them.
- 4. Number separated unnumbered paragraphs.
